Consideration Of Application For Valet Parking Services From The Shalom Foundation For An Event On May 13, 2017, In Downtown Franklin From 5:30 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. (03/14/17 WS)

**Purpose**

The purpose of this memo is to provide information to the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) concerning utilizing City of Franklin parking within the Right of Way and in storage of valet parked vehicles within the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue parking garages for a one-time private event.

**Background**

The City of Franklin has recently adopted an ordinance (Title 16, Chapter 13) which allows for valet parking to occur on City owned streets and parking structures. The Shalom Foundation has made application to be able to have a valet station on 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue occupying on-street parking and shuttle the cars to both the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue parking garages for a one-night event on May 13, 2017.

Staff has reviewed the application materials and ensured that the proposal will comply with the provisions of Title 16, Chapter 13 of the Municipal Code concerning valet parking.

**Financial Impact**

**Recommendation**

Staff recommends allowing use of on street parking spaces and partial use of the two City-owned parking garages on May 13, 2017 from 530 p.m. to 1100 p.m.
