**Purpose**

The purpose of this memo is to provide information to the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) concerning the Professional Services Agreement (COF 2016-0287) with Civil & Environmental Consultants, Inc. for the 1<sup>st</sup> Ave and Bridge Street Construction Plans in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.

**Background**

The Harpeth Square Development team submitted plans and obtained approval on the design for 1<sup>st</sup> Ave and Bridge Street. Following that approval, City staff and the developer reviewed the construction plans and agreed to make some modifications to accommodate a future sidewalk on the north side of the roadway. It was determined that the City of Franklin would be responsible for the cost associated with this redesign.
