Acknowledge Item Approved on Behalf of Board for services between the Tennessee Department of Health and the City of Franklin, COF Contract No. 2016-0182.

#### <u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this memo is to provide information to the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) concerning COF Contract 2016-0182, services between the State of Tennessee Department of Health and the City of Franklin.

#### **Background**

This is a clean-up item. This standard agreement formally states the legal basis for funding health services between the City and the State for the Williamson County Health Department. While a small amount of money is appropriated through the annual budget process, this agreement is a necessary and formal part of delineating which government entity is responsible for providing funds to the Williamson County Health Department. The services defined herein have already been provided; but all contracts approved on behalf of the Board should be formally acknowledged or approved through authority granted by the Board. This item accomplishes just that.

#### Financial Impact

The City's financial impact was \$19,634 in Fiscal Year 2017. This money has already been paid to the

Williamson County Health Department. A further amount is budgeted in FY 2018 and will be distributed throughout the remainder of the fiscal year.

### **Recommendation**

This agreement has been approved through authority previously granted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.
