Purpose

The purpose of this memo is to provide information to the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) concerning the budget proposals for numerous Development & Growth related funds for Fiscal Year 2019-2020.

Background

Each year, the Budget & Finance Committee reviews the detailed budget of each City Department. At the meetings in February, March, and April, departmental staff makes a presentation of the plans for the next budget cycle and the requested funding for those anticipated needs. This provides the Committee with an idea of the size and scope of budget requests that may be included in the City Administrator's proposed budget,

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which is typically delivered at the May committee meeting.

Financial Impact

The financial impact varies by department, depending on the increase in population, the required services, equipment replacement needs, and program enhancements.
