#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this memo is to provide information to the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) concerning the reporting of signed funding agreements for non-profit agencies and entities for FY 2019-2020.

## **Background**

Each year through the budget process, the City of Franklin, Tennessee appropriates an amount of money to non-profit, charitable or volunteer organizations. State law (T.C.A. 6-54-111) requires that the governing body

and the entity receiving taxpayer funding enter into a formal agreement and provide appropriate documentation of financial standing. This item simply reports out that agreements have been reached and signed for 16 different agencies:

## **Financial Impact**

The total amount of money being distributed via these agreements in FY 2020 is \$276,100.
