#### SUBJECT:

Consideration of Event Permit for Franklin High School Homecoming Parade in Downtown Franklin on October 24, 2019. (WS 9/10/19)

#### <u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this memorandum is to outline recommendations for the Franklin High School Homecoming Parade.

#### **Background**

Franklin High School has requested street closures for their annual Homecoming Parade. Their original requested date conflicted with the set-up for Pumpkinfest. The parade has now been set for Thursday, October 24<sup>th</sup>. As in the past, the parade will stage along West Main Street from Five Points to (approximately) 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The parade begins at 10:30 a.m. The route will conclude at Bicentennial Park via Third Ave North. Estimated attendance is 1,600 - 1,700.

#### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends approval with the following conditions:

• Applicant will provide a Good Neighbor letter which will be distributed to affected neighborhoods.

#### • Risk Management:

• Certificate of insurance naming the City as additional insured

### • Police Department:

• Applicant will hire recommended number of Franklin Police Officers to open/close streets and to provide security and traffic control.
