Consideration Of Certificate Of Compliance For Wine In Grocery Stores For Herban Market, LLC, Located At 3078 Maddux Way, Suite 300, Franklin, TN, 37069 (Ashlea Hogancamp, Owner and Managing Agent; Matthew Hogancamp, Owner and Managing Agent)

Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide information to the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) concerning the renewal of a retail sale certificate to a grocery store selling wine.

Background

As of July 1, 2016, any grocery store selling wine must have at least one employee who holds a manager's permit. The City is allowed to issue permits to Grocery stores within the city limits, upon clear background check approvals. The required background checks have been performed on specific company executives and the store's managing agent(s) for the store above; all applicants for this location have passed. This permit is the first step for grocery stores to obtain their State of Tennessee certificate.

The City issued certificate is issued in the name of the co-owners and managers.

Financial Impact

No direct financial impact related to the City of Franklin is anticipated.

Recommendation

Staff recommends renewal of the Wine in Grocery Store Certificate for this location.
