*Consideration of Event Permit for the Turkey Trot Sponsored by Graceworks Ministries on November 22, 2018 in Cool Springs.

Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to outline recommendations for the Turkey Trot run sponsored by Graceworks Ministries.

Background

Graceworks Ministries has submitted an application for their annual Turkey Trot on November 22nd (Thanksgiving Day). Two changes for 2018 - the event begins and ends at Prairie Life Fitness and the event now includes a 10K. Estimated total attendance is 3,500. The route includes the Galleria Blvd, Mallory Lane, and Bakers Bridge.

Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the event application with the following recommendations:

- Applicant will provide a \$1,000 refundable damage deposit to City prior to event.
- Applicant will provide a Good Neighbor letter which will be distributed to affected neighborhoods.
- Applicant will coordinate with management of Cool Springs Galleria.
- Applicant will work with City staff to determine 10K route

Risk Management:

Applicant will provide a certificate of insurance naming the City as additional insured.

Police Department:

- Applicant will hire recommended number of Franklin Police Officers to secure the route.
- Applicant will work with Department on other logistics.

Sanitation and Environmental Services Department:
