Consideration of Ordinance 2018-52, "An Ordinance to Establish a No Parking Zone and to Implement a Pavement Marking and Signage Plan on 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue North, between West Main Street and Fair Street". (Deferred from the 9/27/2018 CIC; 10/25/18 CIC voted 3-0 to refer this item to the 11/13 WS; deferred from 11-13-18 WS, 11-27-18 WS, 12-11-18 WS; 01/08/19 WS; 1/22/19 BOMA 1<sup>st</sup> Reading 8-0). SECOND AND FINAL READING

**Purpose**

The purpose of this memo is to provide information to the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) concerning Ordinance 2018-52.

**Background**

City staff was asked by a resident to investigate parking concerns on 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue North Between West Main Street and Fair Street. The current pavement width is between 30'-32'. To accommodate parking on both sides of the street, the pavement width needs to be a minimum of 38' (2~11' travel lanes and 2~8' parking lanes). Staff proposes to implement a new pavement marking plan and prohibit parking on the northeast side of the roadway as shown in the attached exhibit.

**Financial Impact**

The cost would be less than \$5,000 to perform this work and would be paid out of the Street Department's annual budget.

**Recommendation**

Staff recommends approval of Ordinance 2018-52.
