#### **SUBJECT:**

Consideration of Event Permit for the Turkey Trot Sponsored by Graceworks Ministries on November 28, 2019 in Cool Springs. (05/28/19 WS)

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this memorandum is to outline recommendations for the Turkey Trot run sponsored by Graceworks Ministries.

# **Background**

Graceworks Ministries has submitted an application for their annual Turkey Trot on November 28<sup>th</sup> (Thanksgiving Day). Estimated total attendance is 4,500. The route includes the Galleria Blvd, Mallory Lane, and Bakers Bridge.

### Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the event application with the following recommendations:

- Applicant will provide a \$1,000 refundable damage deposit to City prior to event.
- Applicant will provide a Good Neighbor letter which will be distributed to affected neighborhoods.
- Applicant will coordinate with management of Cool Springs Galleria.
- Applicant will meet with staff at least 60 days before event to finalize routes.

# • Risk Management:

Applicant will provide a certificate of insurance naming the City as additional insured.

## Police Department:

- Applicant will hire recommended number of Franklin Police Officers to secure the route.
- Applicant will work with Department on other logistics.

#### Sanitation and Environmental Services Department:

Applicant will provide volunteers to clean up during and after event.
