Consideration of Ordinance No. 2019-33, An Ordinance Amending Title 16, Chapter 2 of the Franklin Municipal Code regarding Applications, No Construction within the Rights Of Way, Cool Springs Corridor from Thanksgiving Day through New Years Day. (BOMA 9/10/19 1st Reading 8-0) SECOND AND FINAL READING

Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide information to the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) concerning a proposed ordinance to prohibit work within the rights of way for the Cool Springs corridor beginning Thanksgiving Day through New Year's Day annually.

Background

Construction activities within the Cool Springs corridor adversely impacts traffic flow, turn movement and timing during the Holiday Season. All non-essential closures shall cease during the referenced timeframe (Thanksgiving through New Year's Day) unless otherwise approved by the City Administrator or his/her designee.

Financial Impact

Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of Ordinance 2019-33 which would restricting construction activities within the rights of way of the Cool Springs corridor from Thanksgiving through New Year's Day..
